Beginning Quilting...Nancy

Our new beginning quilting class is a 25"x25" wall hanging or table topper that includes four patches and half square



triangles. You will learn fabric selection, accurate cutting and piecing a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. The number of blocks can be increased if you prefer a larger quilt. Hand quilting the block is included in class.


If you are interested in a particular pattern or technique, we will arrange a class for three or more people.
